The Regional Waste System

Like most major infrastructure, landfills are regional in nature and are a part of a larger system that includes a variety of facilities to help us better manage our trash and recycling.

Ventura County is fortunate to have two landfills (SVLRC and Toland Road) that help residents manage more than 90% of solid waste locally. The SVLRC takes in less than two percent of the solid waste generated in Los Angeles County. But, Ventura County is dependent on other communities to manage:

- Hazardous waste
- Tires
- Recyclables such as bottles, cans, paper
- Sewage sludge
