Why the Modernization and Expansion Project is Good for the Community

1. **MAINTAINS MORE THAN 275 GOOD-PAYING JOBS**
in Ventura County
2. **INJECTS MORE THAN \$48 MILLION**
annually into the Ventura County economy
3. **CONTRIBUTES MORE THAN \$3.6 MILLION**
to public agency budgets within Ventura County
4. **IMPROVES RECYCLING** *options and increases environmentally-friendly programs*
5. **INCREASES PRODUCTION** *of enough green energy to power 6,250 local homes*
6. **ESTABLISHES ONE OF THE FIRST LEED FACILITIES**
at a landfill in the county by using recycled and sustainable building materials, energy-efficient lighting, green energy programs and recycled water
7. **REDUCES TRUCK TRAFFIC** *on the Madera Corridor by moving local trucking operations to landfill*
8. **CREATES OVER 500 ACRES** *for open space and wildlife habitats*
