Why the Modernization and Expansion Project is Good for the Community

- 1. MAINTAINS MORE THAN 275 GOOD-PAYING JOBS in Ventura County
- 2. INJECTS MORE THAN \$48 MILLION annually into the Ventura County economy
- 3. CONTRIBUTES MORE THAN \$3.6 MILLION to public agency budgets within Ventura County
- 4. IMPROVES RECYCLING options and increases environmentally-friendly programs
- **5. INCREASES PRODUCTION** of enough green energy to power 6,250 local homes
- 6. ESTABLISHES ONE OF THE FIRST LEED FACILITIES at a landfill in the county by using recycled and sustainable building materials, energy-efficient lighting, green energy programs and recycled water
- 7. REDUCES TRUCK TRAFFIC on the Madera Corridor by moving local trucking operations to landfill
- 8. CREATES OVER 500 ACRES for open space and wildlife habitats
- 9. PROVIDES MORE CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS, including annual sponsorships, charitable service donations and employee volunteer support
